Q: Why did the little boy blush when he opened the refrigerator door?

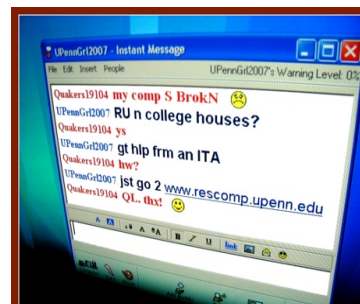
A: Because he saw the salad dressing.
